Online exhibitions permit artists to display their creative accomplishments despite war, the lack of local venues, political repression, or outsider/minority status. Artists can engage universals from the perplexities of love to the horrors of AIDS and bring beauty into the world. The Art Without Borders Café gives community members the tools to communicate easily, the Gallery helps them to make a living as artists, and Resources offers everything from residency opportunities to practical advice.

Personalize the site to your own preferences – select a language, create favorites (art, galleries), set preferences (Asia, women artists), and arrange notifications (gallery openings, new postings).

Registry

A powerful, searchable database of images and artist information built around standard categorization terms. This global repository can be used by scholars, collectors, art lovers, curators and gallery owners.

Exhibitions

Professionally curated exhibitions of works by member artists complete with downloadable catalog, artists statements, resumes and additional images of the artists' work.

The Café

A virtual hang out – engage in threaded discussions, develop ideas for exhibitions, network, find fellow artists and escape isolation.

Resources

A one-stop for useful information from a links library for galleries and museums in the developing and transitional countries to listings of residency programs and practical how to's.

The Gallery

Online gallery assures artists and buyers that transactions will be honest and fair, and local galleries that they will receive their commissions when their artists' work sells.

Who Art Without Borders serves and who can participate

Artists, gallery owners, curators, art funders, collectors, students, professors, journalists and all those interested in the creation, dissemination and documentation of world art. There is no cost to participate. All artists *not* from the United States and Western Europe are invited to post images. Gallery owners are encouraged to ask their artists to post. Curators interested in developing exhibition should propose them.
